To Complete the 2017-2018 School Year

Required by September 14, 2018:

Activities and Services (occurred in summer months Jun-Aug)

- Report all student/parent services in database
- Report all student/parent and teacher activities in database

For Sites Serving 12th Grade Students during 2017-18 School Year

- Update Cumulative Course Completion
 - Pre-Algebra
 - Algebra I or Equivalent
 - Geometry
 - Algebra II
 - Calculus
 - Chemistry
 - Physics
 - At least one advanced placement course
 - Trigonometry
 - Pre-Calculus
 - Biology
 - English & Language Arts
 - At Least One International Baccalaureate Class
 - At Least Two Years of Math Beyond Algebra I
 - Advanced Math
 - Advanced Science
 - Advanced English/Language Arts
- Update Student Progress
 - Students with 10 or more unexcused absences during the 2017-2018 school year (Full day ONLY)
 - Graduated HS – 2017-2018 school year
 - Took the SAT or ACT – 2017-2018 school year
 - SAT and ACT Test Scores – **Please send your School Building's 2018 SAT Data Report and ACT College Readiness Letter available from the school counselor**
 - Completed FAFSA/WASFA – 2017-2018 school year
 - College Coursework in HS – 2017-2018 school year
 - Passed State Grad Standard – Reading, Writing, Math, Science
 - Financial Aid Knowledge Survey results submitted to RGI

For Sites Serving First-Year College Students during 2017-18 School Year

- Update Student Progress
 - College Placement – No remedial courses
 - Enrolled in College – Less than 2 years
 - Enrolled in College – 2 years
 - Enrolled in College – 4 years
 - Enrolled – Fall **and** indicate which Postsecondary Institution enrolled*
 - Enrolled – Spring/Winter **and** indicate which Postsecondary Institution enrolled**
 - Completed 1st year of College

* Check only for students who INTIALLY enroll in college during fall quarter/semester

** Check only for students who INTIALLY enroll in college during Winter/Spring quarter/semester. Please DO NOT check this box if the student persists from Fall to Winter/Spring
